# Shelters

In April 2022, the non-governmental organization Rotary Club Kyiv International launched a large-scale project to equip shelters for internally displaced people in several regions of Ukraine. The aim of the project is to equip and open up to 50 shelters in 12 regions.

As of early June 2022, the Rotary Club team had provided four shelters. Volunteers of the organization ensured effective cooperation with local authorities in the regions and the management of shelters, search for necessary goods, their purchase and delivery, as well as quality control of the work performed. During the arrangement, each of the shelters receives all the goods necessary for the comfortable living of internally displaced persons and meeting their needs. The list of goods provided to shelters includes furniture, household appliances, bedding, etc.

## Rotary Club Kyiv International gave a new home to more than 1000 people

By June 2022, four centers for internally displaced people have been set up and opened in different regions of Ukraine, including:

### 1. Lviv region

Zolochiv city (300 IDPs)

### 2. Ivano-Frankivsk region

Polianytsa village (200 IDPs)

### 3. Zakarpattiia region

Uzhgorod city (300 IDPs)

### 4. Poltava region

Opishnia and other communities (200 IDPs)

# Delivery

# Helping victims with food, medicines, supplies

In May, 2022 the NGO “Rotary Club Kyiv International” was realizing a project in cooperation with The International Organization for Migration.

The aim of the project was to provide aid with non-food items to Ukrainian civilian people which were affected by war in Ukraine.

Volunteers of the Rotary Club Kyiv International have organized all the processes of providing the aid: from purchasing and delivery to making photos of people, who got their assistance.

There were two ways of distribution the non-food items: the first part of products was distributed by volunteers of the Rotary Club Kyiv International to particular civilian people, who were in need; the second one was distributed to government agencies, which passed on the aid to more people in need.

There were three regions where the aid was distributed: Kyiv, Kharkiv and Chernihiv regions.

Ten united territorial communities of these regions were included in the project and has got the humanitarian aid, which they desperately needed.

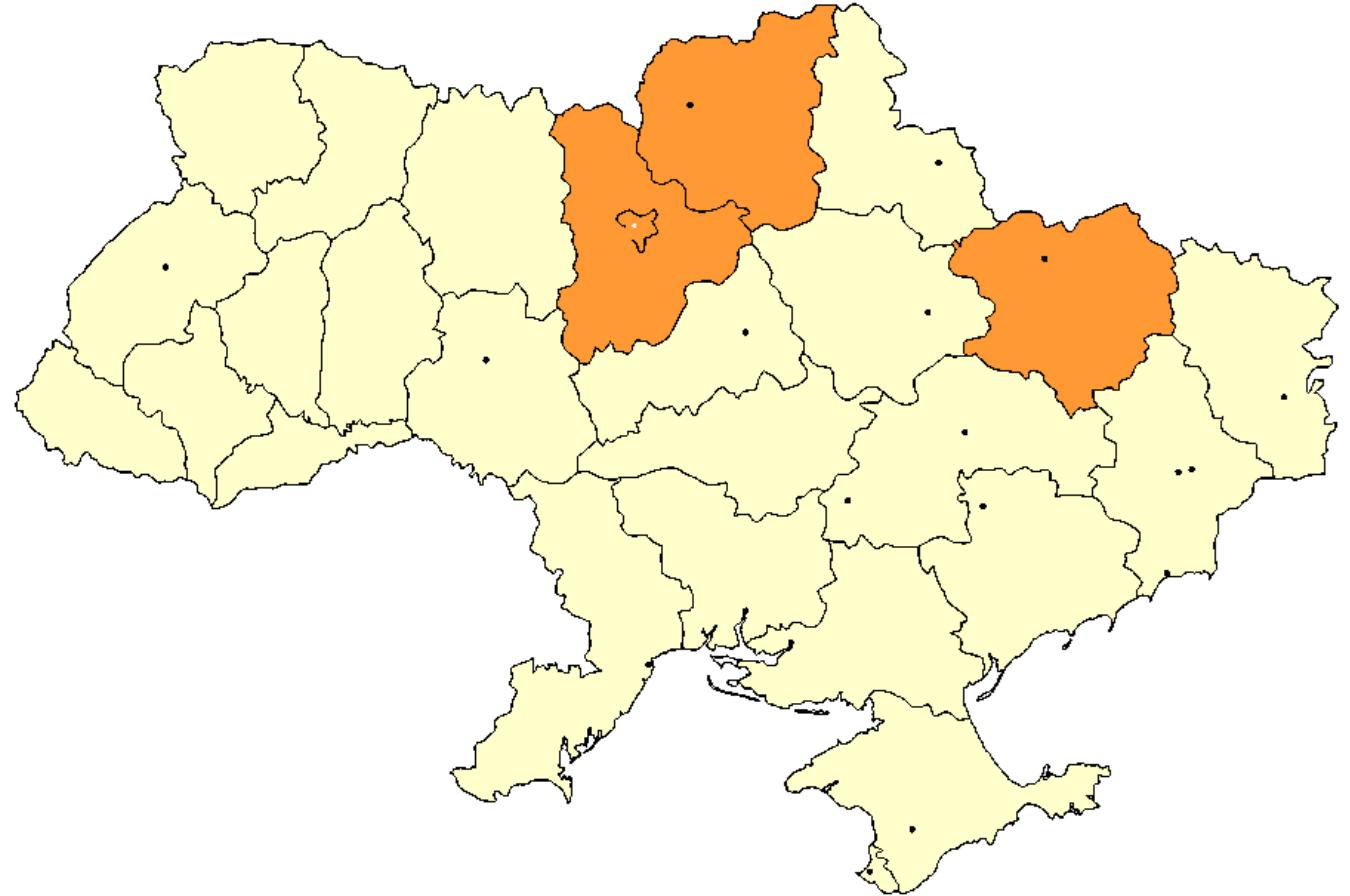

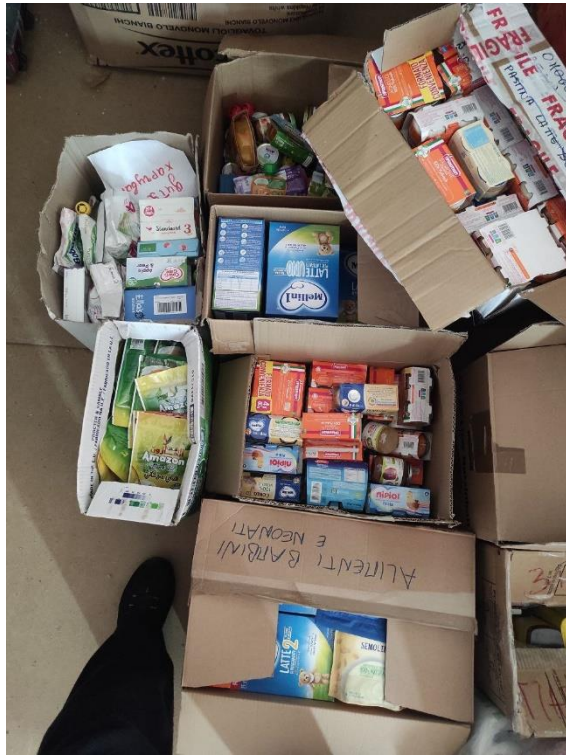

# We deliver food to train personnel

In March 2022, we were providing food to more than 10,000 railroad workers in Kyiv, Poltava and other cities. The first month provided a mass evacuation of people from the east, south and center of Ukraine. Railway personnel did not leave the trains for weeks due to the mass evacuation of the population.

# Kyiv – Chernigiv Team

We are constantly delivering aid to Chernihiv. Buses are always small, because the city is constantly under fire. We deliver food and medicine.



# Uzhgorod - Dnipro Team

We deliver medicine, food, things to the city of Dnipro - more than 10 trips to family-type homes (large families)



# Polianytsa Team

- We delivered more than 20 tons of aid to Dnipro and Chernihiv: food, hygiene products, baby food, clothes

# Bomb shelters

We buy and deliver warm clothes for people in the basements (as well as disposable tableware, thermal mugs, warm socks, sleeping bags, mattresses, water filters)



# Evacuation of citizens from Kyiv

During the period from February 25 to April 1 - almost 1,000 people were evacuated from Kyiv to Lviv who could not allow it (elderly people, people with special needs)



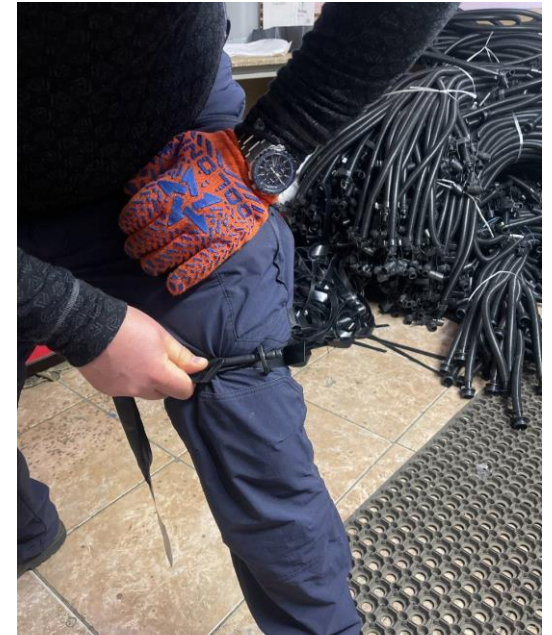


# Help for pets



During the war, many pets remained on the streets. They could not be taken away. Sometimes the owners deliberately throw into the street in evacuation. Our volunteers collect animals, provide shelter, treat and feed them. Our animals are happy, we are with them and we will not leave them!

We are providing gasoline for delivery of aid and to ambulance in the Kyiv region to deliver the wounded



# Chernigiv team

There has been almost no electricity in Chernihiv for more than a month, all food and drinking water has been supplied here only with volunteers for more than a month. There are many villages near Chernigiv where food must be delivered, because they are completely cut off from the city, roads are broken, bridges are blown up. Our Chernigiv team made 10 trips to Chernigiv and villages around Chernigiv during April.





# Dnipro team

Our team of volunteers went to Dnipro 2 times a week and delivered orders to hospitals and nursing homes (adult diapers, medicines to Mechnikova hospital, baby food). Often these were villages near the Dnipro, where few volunteers reach.



# Slavutych and Borodyanka (by Kyiv team)

Our Kyiv team was bringing fresh products to Kyiv region: Borodyanka, Slavutych, Irpin, Bucha. All Kyiv volunteers were helping to restore the region. Citizens needed food, drinking water, hygiene products, support. They made more than 10 trips.



# Volunteers
